Plugin Overview

The **Network Merchants Inc Gateway (NMI) for WooCommerce** is a comprehensive payment processing solution that enables your WooCommerce store to accept credit card payments securely through Network Merchants Inc. (NMI).

Key Features

- PCI DSS Compliant Secure tokenization without storing sensitive card data
- WooCommerce Blocks Support

 Modern checkout experience with React-based payment forms
- **HPOS Compatible** Works with WooCommerce High-Performance Order Storage
- Refund Support Process full or partial refunds directly from WooCommerce
- Debug Logging Comprehensive transaction logs for debugging and monitoring
- Collect.js Tokenization PCI DSS compliant payment processing

Prerequisites

Important: Ensure your WordPress site meets these requirements before installation.

System Requirements

- WordPress: Version 5.8 or higher
- WooCommerce: Version 5.0 or higher
- **PHP:** Version 7.4 or higher (PHP 8.0+ recommended)
- **MySQL:** Version 5.6 or higher
- **SSL Certificate:** Required for secure payment processing

Required Accounts

• NMI Merchant Account: Active Network Merchants Inc merchant account

- API Credentials: Username, Password, and Security Key from NMI
- Collect.js Account: For PCI DSS compliant tokenization

Installation Steps

Step 1: Download the Plugin

After purchasing the plugin, you'll receive a ZIP file named:

network-merchants-inc-gateway-for-woocommerce.zip

Step 2: Upload to WordPress

Method A: WordPress Admin Dashboard

- 1. Log in to your WordPress admin dashboard
- 2. Navigate to **Plugins** → **Add New**
- 3. Click "Upload Plugin"
- 4. Choose the ZIP file and click "Install Now"
- 5. Click "Activate Plugin" after installation

Method B: FTP Upload

- 1. Extract the ZIP file on your computer
- 2. Upload the extracted folder to /wp-content/plugins/
- 3. Activate the plugin from WordPress admin dashboard

Step 3: Verify Installation

✓ Success! The plugin should now appear in:

WooCommerce \rightarrow Settings \rightarrow Payments \rightarrow Network Merchants Inc Gateway

Configuration Guide

Step 1: Access Payment Settings

- 1. Go to WooCommerce → Settings → Payments
- 2. Find "Network Merchants Inc Gateway"
- 3. Click "Manage" or "Configure"

Step 2: Configure Basic Settings

Enable/Disable:

- ✓ Check "Enable Network Merchants Inc Gateway"
- Check "Enable for virtual products" (if applicable)

Step 3: API Configuration

■ Security Note: Keep your API credentials secure and never share them publicly.

Required API Settings:

- **Security Key:** Your NMI security key
- Collect.js Public Key: Your Collect.js public key

Step 4: Test Mode Configuration

For Testing:

- **☑** Enable **"Test Mode"** during initial setup
- Use test card numbers: 4242 4242 4242
- Use any future expiration date and any 3-digit CVC

Step 5: Advanced Settings

Optional Configurations:

- **Debug Logging:** Enable for troubleshooting
- Order Status: Set completion status (default: Processing)
- Payment Method Title: Customize checkout display name
- Payment Method Description: Add helpful text for customers

Testing Instructions

Step 1: Enable Test Mode

Before going live, always test the payment gateway:

- 1. Ensure "Test Mode" is enabled in plugin settings
- 2. Save the configuration

Step 2: Test Payment Processing

Test Card Numbers:

• Visa: 4242 4242 4242 4242

Mastercard: 5555 5555 5555 4444

American Express: 3782 822463 10005
 Declined Card: 4000 0000 0000 0002

Use any future expiration date and any 3-digit CVC

Step 3: Verify Transaction Logs

After test transactions, check:

- 1. Go to **WooCommerce** → **Orders**
- 2. Verify test orders are created
- 3. Check order status and payment details
- 4. Review debug logs if enabled

Step 4: Disable Test Mode

Ready for Production!

Once testing is complete:

- 1. Disable "Test Mode"
- 2. Save configuration

Troubleshooting

Common Issues & Solutions

Payment Declined

Possible Causes:

- Incorrect API credentials
- Test mode enabled with live credentials
- Invalid card information
- Insufficient funds

Solution: Verify API settings and test with different card numbers

Plugin Not Appearing

Possible Causes:

- Plugin not activated
- WooCommerce not installed/activated
- PHP version incompatibility

Solution: Check plugin activation and system requirements

SSL Certificate Issues

Issue: Payment forms not loading or SSL errors

Solution: Ensure your site has a valid SSL certificate

Debug Logging

Enable debug logging for detailed error information:

- 1. Go to plugin settings
- 2. Enable "Debug Logging"
- 3. Check logs at: wp-content/uploads/wc-logs/
